

Manually Register and ActiveX Control

You can provide these instructions to your end users if you are distributing an ActiveX control with your Help system.

1. Locate the file <file name> on your installation CD <provide location>.
2. Right-click <file name> (.OCX or .DLL) and select Copy.
3. Paste the file into the Windows system32 directory

Tip: You can copy the ActiveX control files into a custom folder rather than into Windows\System. If you do this, include the path for the alternate folder in front of the *.OCX or *.DLL file name so Windows can locate the file.

4. Click the Windows Start button, then select Run. [See 6 below for Vista]
5. In Open, type the following:

```
regsvr32 hhactivex.dll
```

Click OK.

6. On Vista use the Start Search option for cmd.exe then right click and Run cmd.exe as Administrator. When the Windows command window shell opens type in

```
regsvr32 hhactivex.dll
```

Press return

and the DLL will register as on other Windows operating systems.
